CLP is a four-day course with a total of 32 hours of training in the following areas for mechanical or conventional logging:

Day 1 - (8 hours in the classroom)

- Intro. to CLP
- CLP Code of Ethics
- Intro. To Safe & Efficient Harvesting
- Transportation Safety
- Intro. To The Business of Logging

Day 2 - (8 hours in the classroom)

- 1st Aid/CPR Training and Certification

Day 3 - (8 hours in the classroom)

- Forest Management & Silviculture
- Conserving Fish & Wildlife
- Water Quality & Logging
- Controlled Yarding
- Hazardous Material Training

Day 4 - (8 hours)

- Level I Game of Logging Training for conventional loggers or Mechanical Harvesting Systems.
- Certification Interview Form Review

Day 5 - Jobsite evaluation for contractor/supervisors. This training day will be scheduled at a later date.

Tuition & Field Interview

Tuition for the CLP class is \$545. This includes all program materials, lunch each day and the field interview for certification.

The field interview will be conducted on the CLP candidate's jobsite within 6 months of completing the class.

Registration Information

Classes are filled on a first pay, first serve basis. **To guarantee a spot in the class of your choice, fill out the registration form in this brochure and mail it back with full tuition payment to the CLP office. Make checks payable to CLP.**

The registration form and \$545 tuition payment must be received at least two weeks prior to the start of your class.

In the event that CLP must relocate or cancel a class, participants will be given a choice of either a full refund or credit towards a different class.

If the participant fails to attend without notifying the CLP office at least one week prior to the start of the class, their \$545 tuition payment will not be refunded. Substitutions will be honored.

## Recert Requirements

To maintain your CLP certification you must recertify the year following your initial certification training, and every two years thereafter. For example: Loggers who received initial certification training in 2008 must recertify in 2009, and again in 2011. Certification remains valid through December 31st of the year in which it expires.

To recertify you must meet the following requirements:

- 1. TRAINING** – You must complete recert training. Requirements are as follows:
  - **Conventional CLPs** who were first certified in 2008 must attend a day long CLP sponsored **Filing and Reduced Downtime** workshop listed in this brochure. Conventional CLPs certified before 2008 must attend a day long GOL felling workshop level II, III, & IV, unless they have been approved to attend alternative training.
  - **Mechanical CLPs** must attend a day workshop geared toward the mechanical logger.
  - **Contractor/Supervisor CLPs** must attend a day CLP sponsored workshop or an approved workshop. You are required to attend the **Jobsite Evaluation** workshop if you have not already met the requirement, otherwise alternative workshops or approved sessions are available.
  - **Associate CLPs** can fulfill their training requirements by attending any workshop listed in this brochure. Several outside workshops have also been approved for recertification and are listed on the CLP website ([www.clploggers.com](http://www.clploggers.com)). Call the office for approval of any workshops not listed that you wish to attend. **Please send verification of any workshops attended to receive credit.**
- 2. INSPECTION** – CLPs must pass a recert field inspection to retain certification. **It is the responsibility of each CLP to contact the office and request an inspection.** CLP reserves the right to conduct random inspections for any certified member.
- 3. FIRST AID SKILLS** – CLPs will be expected to maintain First Aid and CPR skills. Our website has a list of classes being offered this Spring by Kim Lynch of Primary Care Consultants.

### **Recertification**

One day recertification classes are held in the spring and fall. Class locations and dates may change based on registration. Additional training locations are available if a minimum of participants are met.

Certification for those who recertify in 2009 remain valid until December 31, 2011.

All candidates for recertification will receive information regarding exact dates, times, and locations prior to the start of the class. It is very important to pre register!

Classes normally run from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Lunch is not included so please bring your own.

### Recertification Tuition

The tuition (\$150) and the registration form must be received by CLP before the training day. Payment in advance or on the day of the class is required. You will not be given credit for the class without payment.
