## Tuition & Field Interview

The field interview will be conducted on the CLP candidate's jobsite within 6 months of completing the class.

**The registration form and \$550 tuition payment must be received at least one week prior to the start of your class. You will not be given credit for the class without payment.**

In the event that CLP must relocate or cancel a class, participants will be given a choice of either a full refund or credit towards a different class.
