

Recert Requirements

To maintain your CLP certification you must recertify the year following your initial certification training, and every two years thereafter, followed by a site visit. For example: Loggers who received initial certification training in 2018 must recertify in 2019 and again in 2021. Certification remains valid through December 31st of the year in which it expires.

1. **TRAINING** ó You must complete recertification training.

Requirements are as follows:

- **Conventional CLPs** must attend a day long GOL felling workshop or a CLP classroom workshop unless they have been approved to attend alternative training. Additional felling workshops may be available upon request.
 - **Mechanical CLPs** must attend a day workshop specific to the mechanical logger.
 - **Contractor/Supervisor CLPs** must attend a day CLP sponsored workshop or an approved workshop. You are required to attend the **Jobsite Evaluation** workshop if you have not already met the requirement.
 - **Associate CLPs** may fulfill their training requirements by attending any workshop listed in this brochure. Several outside workshops have also been approved for recertification and are listed on the CLP website (www.clploggers.com). Call the office for approval of any workshops not listed that you wish to attend.
2. **Evaluation** - CLPs must pass a recertification field evaluation to retain certification. **It is the responsibility of each CLP to contact the office and request an inspection.** CLP reserves the right to conduct random inspections for any certified member.
 3. **FIRST AID SKILLS** ó CLPs will be expected to maintain First Aid and CPR skills.

Spring 2019 Recertification

One day recertification classes are held in the spring and fall. Class locations and dates may change based on registration. Additional training locations are available if a minimum of participants are met.

Certification for those who recertify in 2019 remain valid until December 31, 2021. Tuition and class meet requirements for two calendar years.

All candidates for recertification will receive information regarding exact dates, times, and locations prior to the start of the class.

It is very important to pre register!

Classes normally run from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm. Lunch is not included.

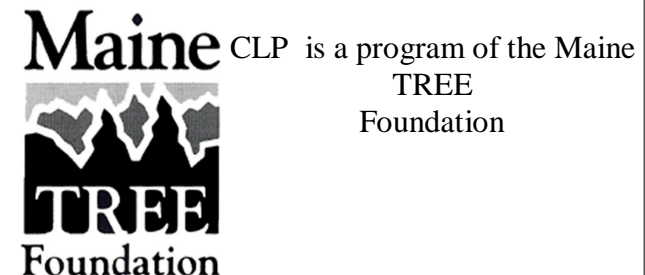
The tuition (\$125.00) and the registration form must be received by CLP before the training day. Class size is limited, so register early to guarantee your spot at the location of your choice.
